- Custodial staff have been preparing the building according to the latest up to date information

### **New Business/Motions (Maura Simms)**

- PTA board voting couldn't take place, but we were able to appoint Karen and Jessica as Vice Presidents, per the by-laws. Voting will take place when we can meet in person.
- Book Bank: Our membership expired in August. The cost for membership is \$100 per year for unlimited books. This allows teachers to have access to books to make available to the students. Jessica Armacost moved to renew our membership. Emily seconded the motion.
- Box Tops has decreased since it became digital. Option for a collection box was discussed.
- Our annual financial review is coming up, which will be completed by Alexandra Buscemi.
- The Reflections program is a creativity contest through the National PTA that promotes arts in education. The Baltimore County chair would like to know if we want to participate. The theme this year is, "I Matter Because". An email will be sent to Lori Goodman to see if she would like to partner with the PTA to implement it.

## **Committee Reports/Upcoming Events**

- Scholastic Book Fair: We are doing a virtual book fair from October 28-November 10. Wil ask teachers and Mr. Knox to promote, closer to the event date.
- Spirit Wear: We are waiting on final mock-ups which will include the "7DE Family" design that we purchased for teachers. Sale will launch next week or so.
- Yearbook: Was a challenge last year. We are in the process of selecting a company to
  use for this year (Jostens, Shutterfly). LifeTouch offered a discount, but wasn't ideal to
  work with. They will still do the portraits. We are looking at pushing back the launch day
  in order to utilize spring portraits and end of year activities. We will be revising as health
  metrics change.
