Principal's Report (Heather Denmeyer)

- Art club can return to in-person on 1/24.
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Treasurer's Report (Brooke)

- The annual registration is up to date.
 - Two lines were added to the budget for the Dough Run and Plant Sale fundraisers.
 - My Neighbors Foundation check was sent out and the Book Fair check was deposited.
 - The budget is currently in the positive.
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New Business/Updates (Maura Simms)

- My Neighbors Foundation Door Decorating fundraiser brought in \$865.55. Linda was thrilled and will be posting photos on the organization's website. They sent us a letter for tax purposes. Next year's theme will be The World Cup.
 - Yearbook sales are live now, as well as fifth grade ads. Parents must design the ad when they purchase them. The deadline is 2/7. 17 yearbooks have been sold so far. Cover voting went well and two submissions were clear winners.
 - The Dough Run fundraiser brought in \$219.86.
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Committee Reports/Upcoming Events

- Spirit Nights: Chik Fila Spirit Night is scheduled for April 5th. Woodfire reached out about having another Spirit Night in February or March. Places we can reach out to about Spirit Nights include: Mason Dixon Diner, Vince's Deli, Miniature Golf, Moe's.
- Magnets: Maura ordered 400 of the smaller sized circular magnets in Hereford colors with the 7DE logo. The cost was \$600 for 400 magnets which will be enough for each family in the school plus extras for new families. We can reorder when needed.
- Jess A. asked about teacher reimbursements. So far, none of the teachers have applied for reimbursements. Jenn D. will send out a reminder email.
- Using part of our classroom enrichment budget to purchase supplies for teachers: Plans begin in early March for the following year. The staff can discuss school supply lists during the April meeting and the PTA can possibly provide some items from the lists to lighten the load for parents and teachers.
- Rec Council (Rob E.): Basketball is starting to wrap up it's season. Soccer begins in the first week of February. Baseball registration is open. Taekwondo has some openings left. Beth F. has stepped down as Lego Club Commissioner and that position is open for next year. Lego Club will not run this year due to Covid. The field updates are almost completed and the new boxes are installed. The county has been asked about basketball hoop updates, but it will likely be a lengthy process to update those facilities. Heather D. will send some photos of the current condition of the basketball court to help the process along. The Rec Council was informed that the current Community Supervisor of Parks and Rec is moving and we will be getting a new one soon. Theater will be back this summer with two shows running in August.
