Principal's Report (Heather Denmeyer)

- Thank you to the PTA for everything this year. The feedback from the community has been overwhelmingly positive.
- Looking forward to the Fifth Grade Farewell. The signs have been ordered from Signs By Tomorrow. Parents have really appreciated the ceremony being held in the evening at the high school.
- We are continuing to give out the birthday books for the summer birthdays and will do the birthday books again next year. The PTA still has scholastic dollars to spend on books.
- We will send out an email thanking parents for contributing to the PTA, with a list of everything that the PTA was able to do for students and teachers throughout the year with their support.
- Teachers are in need of new rugs. Must be school grade and fire resistant. We have \$3,000 in teacher enrichment budget and \$1500 in classroom enrichment budget that we can use. Must be 9X12 color block rugs like they carry at Lakeshore.
- There will be a few staffing changes next year. We are adding a kindergarten teacher. Mrs. Vyskocil will be retiring.
- As of now, we are not able to put a traffic mirror on York Rd.
- As a school, we are always re-evaluating what we do in emergency situations and how we can make it better for next time. All school doors must always be locked and classroom doors should be closed and latched. The goal of our drills is for kids to know what to do with the least amount of stress. We have rally points and safehouses set up in the area.
- We would like to have a few back to school nights in the fall- one for fun, one for safety, where parents can ask questions, and one about mental health and how we can best support our students.

Treasurer's Report (Brooke)
